


ONE-BEDROOM APARTMENTS IN SANTA MARIA, SAL ISLAND, CAPE VERDE

Two-room apartments with kitchenette, bathroom, and balcony on the 1st and 3rd floors, 500 meters from Santa Maria beach (towards the pier) and 300 meters from the pedestrian street. The apartment is 10 minutes from Santa Maria beach and 6 minutes from the pedestrian street.



Maximum capacity is up to 5 people: 1 bedroom with double bed and 2 sofa beds in the living room

Apartment amenities for guests:

Conditions:

- 1. The agreed price includes bed linen, bathroom and kitchen towels, and a welcome kit consisting of 2 rolls of toilet paper, 2 coffee capsules, 2 tea bags, 1 bottle of water, liquid soap dispensers, and dishwashing detergent.
- 2. Check-in from 3 p.m.
- 3. Check-out by 12 p.m.
- 4. A deposit of €50 may be requested at check-in, which will be returned on the day of check-out after the apartment has been checked.
- 5. The legal quiet hours in Santa Maria are from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.

Important Information: Please inform us in advance of your arrival time.

Other Information:

Espargo Airport is 16 km from Santa Maria (+/- 20 min. by car).

There are taxis and public transport vans outside the airport. The taxi fare starts at €20 and the van fare starts at €1.20/person. If you wish, you can contact our TAXI SERVICE Autenlindo do Rosário directly on WhatsApp (+238) 9849520.

The people of Cape Verde are friendly and cheerful, but given their economic situation, travelers will be approached several times on the street to buy souvenirs, tour packages, etc. So take this in a natural way.

Santa Maria is a safe city with a strong police presence and no crime.

The island of Sal has no spring water, so seawater is desalinized to make drinking water. Due to this particularity and the fact that travelers are not used to drinking desalinized water, we recommend that you always drink bottled water.

The exchange rate used by locals is 100\$ = 1€, although the official exchange rate is 110\$ = 1€.

SUGGESTIONS:

If you don't want to cook during your vacation, the Hotel Sobrado, right across from the apartment, offers buffet meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner with drinks included) and à la carte dining at the Piri-Piri restaurant. Simply go to the hotel or restaurant reception and inform them that you are a guest of the apartments. Our guests receive a 15% discount. To take advantage of the discount, please inform us if you intend to have your meals at the Hotel Sobrado restaurant.

For our guests who love the gym, you can use the Hotel Sobrado gym for €20/week or €5/day.

Supermarkets:

In addition to the various Chinese supermarkets in Santa Maria, we recommend two due to their price/quality ratio:

CAZU - Cape Verdean supermarket, a 5-minute walk from the apartments on Av. João de Deus Maximiano.

DISTRI - mini-market next to the Belo Horizonte hotel that sells Amanhecer brand products from the Portuguese Jerónimo Martins group. It is located on the avenue of hotels, about a 15-minute walk from the apartments.

Restaurants:

There are several restaurants for tourists on the pedestrian street. However, we recommend the following restaurants:

FLOR DE SAL - located next to Praça Manuel António Martins, known as Praça do Presidente or the square with the "SANTA MARIA" sign. This restaurant has live music on Saturdays and Sundays. Friendly and attentive staff. The owner of the restaurant is Portuguese and her name is Matilde. For lunch, they serve cachupa and chicken stew, which is the house specialty. PORTO ANTIGO and CARLOS are two Portuguese restaurants where the quality is above average.

If you want more affordable restaurants with good Cape Verdean food, you can eat at CHAM, six minutes from the apartments on Av. João de Deus Maximiano (100 meters from the CAZU supermarket) or at BAR DE NÓS AUGUSTO (located on the same street as CHAM, 10 minutes from the apartments).

On the pedestrian street, we recommend COMPAD, CAFÉ CRIOLO, or COLONIAL.

Guided Tours:

To explore the island, we recommend Grão D'Sal, a Portuguese agency that works exclusively with Portuguese tourists and in Portuguese. Tours are conducted in small groups, allowing for more personalized attention from the guide. Reservations must be made at least one week in advance via WhatsApp (+238) 5852860 or email graodsal19@gmail.com. Mention that you are with Sérgio Silvestre to receive the tour of Santa Maria. Luggage Storage:



In addition to storing luggage, this company offers a changing room service so you can take one last dip in the sea at Santa Maria beach and freshen up before you leave. Entry visa requirements for Cape Verde:

In order to enter Cape Verde, travelers must pre-register at www.ease.gov.cv.

In the travel information section, travelers must indicate that they are going on vacation, provide their arrival flight number, and their address in Cape Verde.

In this field, you should click on "other" and write that you are staying at Entrada de Santa Maria, Bairro de São Paulo, 67, 1ºB or 3º G (depending on the apartment you have rented), Santa Maria, Ilha do Sal.
